The committee's study shall include, but not be limited to: 12(a) A review of the findings of the commission to study palliative care and associated 13quality of life (2013, 225), a determination as to whether the commission's recommendations are 14being followed and whether the recommendations are effective. 15(b) A review of initiatives in other states on palliative care and end-of-life legislation. 16II. The committee may solicit any information from any person or entity the committee deems relevant to its study. 1718 4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from 19among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house 20member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this 21section. Four members of the committee shall constitute a quorum. 225 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed 23legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house 24clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2019. 6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage. 25
